Dusty tested Equine Colic Relief

Product Review - Equine Colic Relief

Colic. A horse owners nightmare. Most horse owners are aware of the seriousness of colic and do their best to maintain a regular feeding schedule and all the other things that we can do to try to prevent it. But sometimes, it just happens.

Do you have a plan of action in a case colic? Typically we call the vet and he/she comes out and administers a sedative and gives the horse a big dose of mineral oil. And we walk and walk the horse. I have heard that walking a colicky horse has been debated as something possibly not good because it tires an already sick, hurting horse. On the other hand, we are told to do whatever it takes to keep a horse from rolling when they have colic.

But now there is a new product on the market and I had the opportunity to test it last night. It is called [Equine Colic Relief](#). This product claims that within 10-30 minutes your horse will have bowel sounds and an impacted horse will pass a stool in 1-3 hours. It does not claim to be able to help a horse with a twisted gut.

Yesterday afternoon at feeding time my horse Dusty was laying down, and not interested in getting up.

We fed the other horses while keeping an eye on him, and then came back to talk to Dusty, who was still just laying there. We persuaded him to stand up, and then we were able to listen for bowel sounds, and there were none. He was also slightly sweaty and clenching his teeth. His gums were pink, and I took that as a good sign. Dusty laid back down, but was quiet. We decided to try giving him a dose of Equine Colic Relief since he was not rolling.

9:00 standing, no pawing a few little gut noises are heard

9:23 standing, big gut noise

9:30 standing, no pawing, small gut noises on both sides

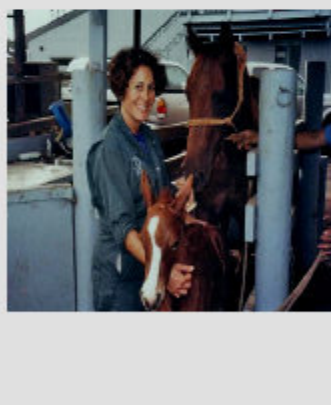
