My friends at the stable helped me give her a bottle of ECR; we did it with her lying down and just waited. It took about 20 minutes and her ears started to go forward instead of back and she opened her eyes more. After about 30 minutes she got up seeming normal again.



Ears start to go forward. You can see some dribbles of the ECR just left of her nose.



After about 45 minutes to an hour, she went back to eating her dinner. I checked on her all night long and she seemed fine. Thanks again to ECR. This is an aged mare (26) and seems to colic more than my other horses. Every time ECR helped her through it. She is the best kids' horse and we love her.
